This is made up of 38 miles, 5 furlongs of large rivers; 12 large locks.

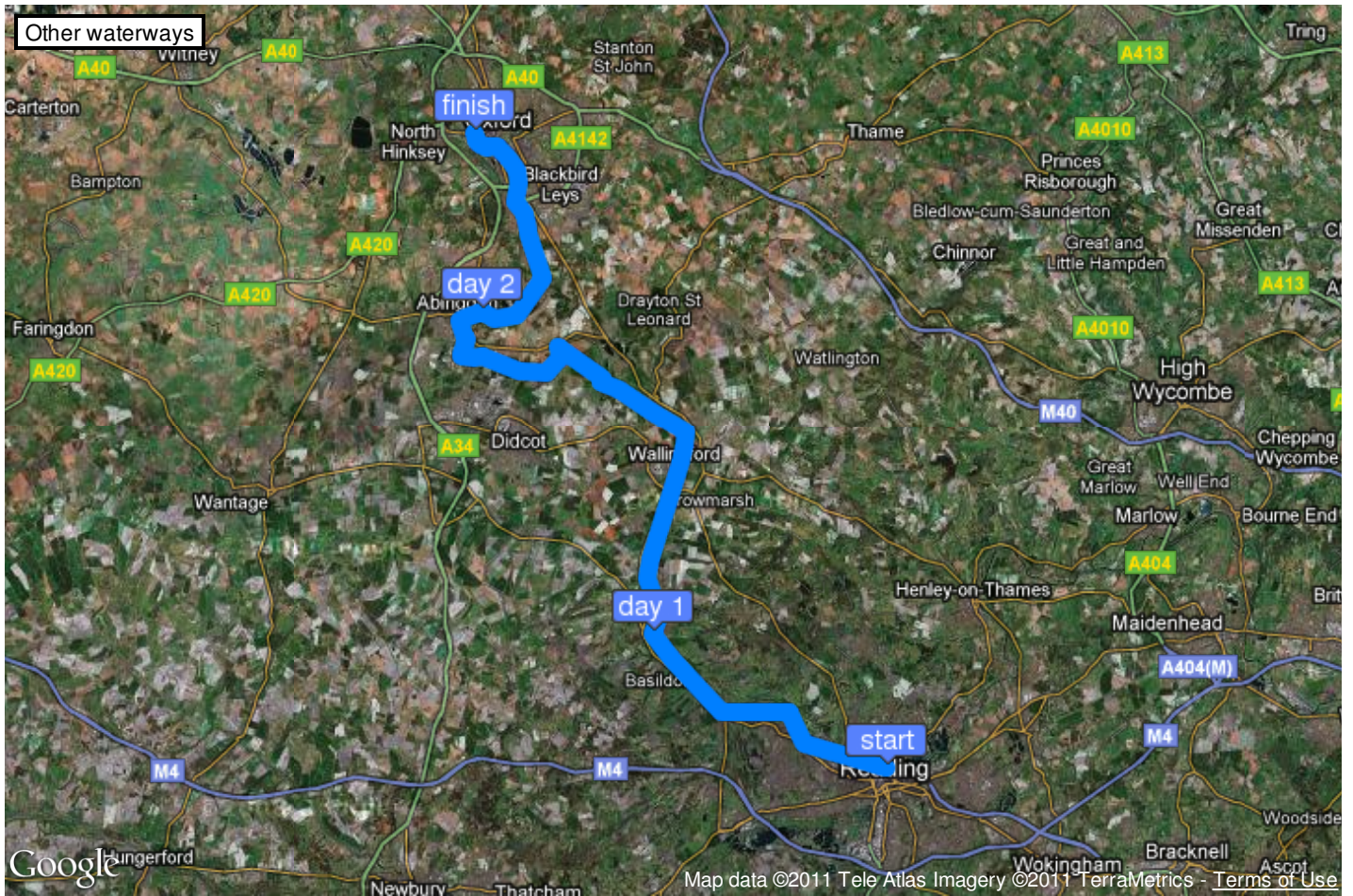
